What is the Weatherization Repair and Assistance Program (WRAP)?

The WRAP program is a federally funded program for low income seniors that is administered through New York State and Albany County.

WRAP provides a comprehensive home energy assessment and home energy plan of action.

WRAP funds may pay for:

- ◆ Attic, wall or floor insulation
- ◆ Window or door replacement or repair
- ◆ Weather stripping and caulking to stop drafts
- ◆ Repair and replacement of heating systems



How can the WRAP program help save me money?

The program helps you to permanently reduce your energy bills by making your home or apartment more energy efficient. The improvements will also help stop drafts and make your home more comfortable in the winter and summer.

The energy costs saved can leave you with more income to help pay for other necessities such as food, clothing or medical care.

If I am an Albany County resident and 60 or older how can I find out if I am income eligible for the program?

Eligibility for the WRAP program is determined by your total household income. (If you are eligible for HEAP or Food Stamps you are eligible for WRAP).
